THE PROJECT

The project intends to provide students with **entrepreneurial knowledge** so that they can be prepared for a career in the world of entrepreneurship. This will help to combat the phenomenon of NEET (not in employment, education or training) by **providing young people with new career opportunities** and facilitating the entry of SEN students into the sector, who find it more difficult to see concrete opportunities for employability in the world of work.

OBJECTIVES

Create:

1. AN INNOVATIVE PEDAGOGICAL APPROACH to school education by combining inclusion with an entrepreneurial experience.
2. AN INCLUSIVE ENTREPRENEURIAL PROJECT to teach students not only about entrepreneurship but also about innovation and inclusion
3. A PLATFORM ONLINE where students can confront themselves with other students and address other issues related to SOCIAL INCLUSION, SOLIDARITY and ENTREPRENEURSHIP.



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KICK OFF MEETING

The kick-off meeting of the MICR@S project took place on 17 and 18 January 2023 in Brussels, hosted by the CCBI coordinator.

During this meeting, the consortium partners met to plan the activities of the 24-month project. Dissemination, project management and quality monitoring activities were discussed and presented.
